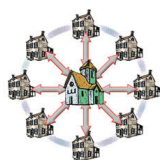

## **THOUGHT FOR AUGUST 2010**

We've had lots to celebrate so far over the summer: Confirmations, Father's day, the last 10 years at Weston, Harvest in the allotment. And we've got more to come as two couples from our church family prepare to get married in August and folk go away on camps, to new Wine and holidays.
